Why are you running for this position? What in your background has led you to run? (100 word limit)

I am running to support my community and to fight for a better future. I want every child to have a path to be successful and to live in a safe and healthy community. I try to create policies using an equity and social justice lens. South King County is beautifully diverse but struggles with health disparities. We are teaming up with University of Washington to address airport impacts including exposure to ultrafine participles from Jet A fuel/other sources and finding ways to mitigate these impacts. My priorities are improving the health outcomes including families with children with asthma, expanding behavioral health crisis services (988), and expanding green energy (e.g. increasing the supply of biofuels, solar, electrifying airplanes and ferries).

What are your most significant accomplishments on environment and climate change?

Rep. Fitzgibbon has been our environmental champion in the House and I support his efforts especially on the clean fuels standards. I am part of the CACC to site another airport which we would be located in a more remote area and use clean technology to decrease the health and environmental impacts. I worked a couple years to pass a HB 1165 to have condo/HOA allow for drought resistant or wildfire ignition-resistant landscaping and to encourage state funded major facility projects to seek all possible water-efficient landscaping credits.

Briefly list organizations, events, rallies, canvassing, referendums, or petitions you have engaged in to advocate for environmental protections?

Helped organize/facilitate/present at an Aviation Solutions Summit which a was multiple state/international forum on airport impacts and solutions. It was set up in partnership with community leaders, elected officials (local, state and federal) and researchers. It included a session on emerging and alternative technologies, fuel and transportation solutions (amazing speakers: Rep. Fitzgibbon, Tim Zenk and Yolanka Wulff).

Testified at EPA hearing to recommend they regulate ultrafine participles. Attended press conferences on Clean Fuel Standards and air quality.

If elected or re-elected what specific environment, climate change, biodiversity, and environmental justice legislation will you prioritize and champion?

I want to support all of the environment justice work but areas that I plan to focus on: 1) expanding solar energy-how can we have our warehouse/manufacturing area of the 33rd have more solar panels on the roofs; 2) expansion of biofuels including aircraft fuel; 3) more work to eliminate airport impacts including use of Hepa filters in the community; 4) elimination of leaded fuel in planes in our community.

For state office positions, what action will you take to accelerate efforts towards Washington State's 2030 Climate Goals, specifically a 45% reduction of carbon pollution below 1990 levels?

I will work closely with you and Rep. Fitzgibbon as you led the way to carbon-neutral electricity by 2030. From increasing energy efficiencies in buildings & homes, expanding green/alternative energy, to electrifying our planes and ferries. Please let me know how I can be a good partner.
